- > Identifying a Confined Space and its hazards
- > The legal requirements

- > Equipment required to enter a Confined Space, including Gas Monitoring equipment, Tripods and Winches and ancillary safety equipment such as harnesses, ropes and lifelines
- > The use of open circuit (CABA) Escape Breathing **Apparatus**

- > Personal Protective Equipment and Hygiene
- > Examination, testing and maintenance of equipment
- > Ventilation and the avoidance of unsafe atmospheres
- > Communication and entry procedures
- > Training and personnel requirements
- > Practical training and exercises
